## Penderlea Museum Associate

### I. Definition:

The Museum Associates' role is to serve on/oversee the special committees that carry out the tasks and projects deemed necessary to the advancement of the Penderlea Homestead Museum by the Board of Directors. The Museum Associates will report directly to the Museum Board of Directors and are bound by all of the policies and rules established by the "Penderlea Homestead Museum Incorporated By-Laws." Museum Associates are non-voting participants in the Museum.

### II. Qualifications:

Any citizen of the United States that is at least 18 years of age and has shown a sincere interest in the success of the museum may submit a formal request and application. Such application shall outline the applicant's skill-set, presented as a form of in-kind donation, which will be presented to the board at the next regular meeting and approved or disapproved. Approval of applications will be based on the needs of the museum at the time of the appointment. Applicants who are approved shall become Museum Associates for a term of one year with the option to renew at the end of the appointment.

### III. Responsibilities:

- 1.) Museum Associates are required to meet quarterly, either collectively or on individual committees, and be available for special meetings as required by the needs of any project they have committed to.
- 2.) At least one Museum Associate must be available to present status reports at the Board of Director Meetings.
